Dear Parents,

The children this week have had a busy week across the curriculum. They got a lot out of their Streetwise sessions and we will have another one next week.

English – The children continued with Kensuke's Kingdom. We wrote Tanka Poems about Michael's Jelly Fish attack. This allowed the children the chance to consolidate their knowledge of how to use figurative language. The children also reviewed Relative Pronouns and answered a variety of questions to consolidate their knowledge.

Maths – The children learnt about multiplying non-unit and unit fractions by integers. They were provided with a variety of problem solving, reasoning and fluency questions to consolidate their knowledge. The children then learnt how to multiply mixed numbers by integers and answered a variety of questions on this.

Topic – The children continued with their Viking topic and learnt about Viking life and farming settlements. The children explored how Vikings lived and built their own long houses. In Art and DT the children started their Jerusalem Diorama and researched the place they will be creating. They considered their design and how they would recreate it. In Science the children conducted experiments about Friction and used Newton Meters to measure force.

Jewish Studies – Children prepared for Lag BaOmer by looking at Lag Baomer over three time periods: Torah times, when the Jewish people journeyed to Har Sinai, Temple times, when 'omer' offerings of barley were brought and Roman times, when the lives of Rabbi Akiva and Rabbi Shimon Bar Yochai clashed with the Roman empire. The children produced their own cartoon strips to tell these various stories. We also continued with our Hebrew reading for meaning in guided groups.

Ivrit – Year 5 have carried on learning about Lag Ba'omer. The key words include: בְּטָטָה - esh (fire), מְדֹּרֶה - medura (Bonfire), בְּטָטָה - tapu'ac adama (potato), בְּטָטָה - batata (sweet potato), חומוס - pitta, סָלָט יִשְׂרָאֵלי - Hummus, סָלָט יִשְׂרָאֵלי – Israeli salad (salat yisra'eli), עוּגַה - cake (uga).

They are creating sentences using language pattern with ־;- ze (that is – male), זאָת - ze (that is – female), אַיך לי - with (im), יַשׁ לִי - I have (yesh li), אַיך לי - l don't have (ein li) & שֵׁלִי - mine (sheli).

The class carried on learning the song שיר ילדים לל"ג בעומר אש בוערת// מירב האוסמן מירב האוסמן for Lag Ba'omer: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=3lCguENW9so and the first verse and chorus of the song שיר עד - הפינג'אן - חיים חפר | עממי ארמני | בביצוע יוסי בנאי — HaFinjan (The coffee pot): https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=kGhYW2DabR0
