Dear Parents,

This week the children have been working very hard and have been extremely productive.

Maths

In Maths this week we have started our work on fractions. We started by reviewing work on quarters and halves. We did this using a paper plate and divided the plate according. We have explored halves and quarters in shapes, objects and lengths. We have also this week reviewed the order of multiplication and division and how they relate.

English

In English this week the children have been looking at Funni in much more detail. We have explored her emotions and she is feeling. We addressed the Zones of Regulation when completing this task. This has been a great plan for the diary entry the class will be writing next week. The class have also learnt about apostrophes for contraction this week and are building up the confidence to include these in their writing next week.

Other areas of the curriculum

This week in Science the children have begun looking closely at plants. We have discussed the stages of a plant growing. The class have even planted their own beans and will enjoy watching them grow throughout the next few weeks. The class have learnt about the function of the different parts of a plant and how they are used to grow. The class have also worked very hard in designing and creating bird feeders. These will look beautiful in your gardens.

Jewish Studies

This week in Jewish Studies, the children have been learning about the various customs that people do to celebrate Shavuot. These customs include hanging up flowers around our shuls and schools to remember that on Har Sinai (Mount Sinai) flowers grew to make the mountain look nice before the giving of the Torah, reading Megillat Rut and eating dairy foods.

<u>Ivrit</u>

This week Year 2 carried on learning to say שוּתָה/שוֹתֶּה - shoteh/shotah (drink m/f), שוֹתָה - ochel/ochelet (eat m/f), חָלָב - chalav (milk), יוֹגוּרְט - yogurt (yogurt), הְּלִידָה - chalav (milk), חַג שָׁמַחַ - Yogurt (yogurt), הָּלִידָה - glidah (ice cream), הַג שָׁמָחַ - gvinah (cheese), אַנִי - ani (I am), הַג שָׁמַחַ - Chag same'ach (Happy festival), שבועות - Shavuot (weeks), שֹלְה - אוֹרָה - Shoko (chocolate milk), שַּמֶּנָת - shamenet (cream) for Shavuot.
