Dear Parents,

We have had a great first week back in Year 3! The children have enjoyed their Ukulele lesson where they learned to play some more tunes. Maths

In Maths, the children have been consolidating their knowledge about place value, partitioning and halving using partitioning. The children have been learning to spot the number patterns in the sequence and explain the way they solved the problem. Also, we have been exploring the grid method for multiplication and multiplying three digit numbers by one digit.

We are continuing to revise all times tables. Please make sure that your child is practising their times tables by playing TT Rockstars.

English

In English, we have been looking at the features of a biography. We explored the language specific to this form to support the children's creative writing. The children were planning biographies of a famous sports person. Also, we have been consolidating our knowledge about 1st person and 3rd person.

Science

In Science, the children have been looking at the human skeleton. We have learnt to label the main bones in human body. Also, we researched why the skeleton is essential to our body.

Jewish Studies

This week we have been delving into Avram's life in our Chumash lessons and we have understood what a great thing he did by following Hashem's commands and thus being responsible for the whole of Bnei Yisrael.

Ivrit

Year 3 are preparing for the Hebrew theatre performance they are going to watch as part of the Festival of Spoken Ivrit.
