Dear Parents,

The children have settled back nicely into school and have got back into the routine of being back at school. The weather has been lovely and they have enjoyed working in the shade, playing outside and making the most of summertime. We have had some lovely learning opportunities that have taken advantage of the weather this week.

English — The children began to explore our new book of the half term 'The Lion, The Witch and The Wardrobe'. The children have read the whole of Chapter 1 and have focused on answering some comprehension questions based around this chapter. The children used the scene of Lucy entering the wardrobe to consolidate descriptive language and expanded noun phrases.

Maths – The children have been learning about Geometry and have learnt about reflecting shapes. They were able to describe reflections and draw reflected shapes. They solved a variety of problems including reasoning questions, fluency questions and participated in a variety of guided group discussions using what they had learnt to solve the questions.

Topic – This week the children continued with their topic of Extreme Survivors. The children have continued to explore classifying and grouping animals. The children used the information from the database to answer a variety of questions and label different animals and what groups they are from. The children continued with our Animal themed collage activity. They continued with the medium of watercolour, which they have added from the oil pastel layer of the previous week. In PE, the children have had a focus on athletics in the build up to the Sports Festival.

Jewish Studies – We have been very busy preparing for Etgar this week, with the children working on revising various aspects of their booklets to get their Jewish general knowledge as sharp as they can. Etgar is taking place next week Wednesday and will be live streamed into our classroom – we cannot wait!

Ivrit – Our Ivrit play is also happening next week and children have continued to prepare for that. For the Festival of Spoken Ivrit, Year 5 will be watching: 'Me and the Lane' (Ani vehamaslool) אֲנִיּ
