We have had a very productive and busy week this week!

English

In English this week the class have been drawing the treasure they think Claude is going to find. They have then been planning their stories about Claude finding the treasure. The class have also been continuing their work on homophones and have been focusing on comparative suffixes.

Maths

This week the class have been focusing on time. This week we have been looking at 5 minute intervals and how to say timings when focusing on minutes. The class have confidently been looking labelling clocks and using this to tell the time at different points in the day.

This week the class have completed filming for the End of Term Video. They have worked very hard on reflecting on the year and themselves. Jewish Studies
