This week in Heads Up Kids, we discussed how we support each other. We played a game called Support Team, where children had to work together in groups, following instructions about how many body parts could touch the floor at a given time, e.g. 2 feet and 2 hands. We then made the game more challenging and the teacher gave out two stickers to each group and placed them on randomly selected arms and legs - these parts could no longer be used in the game. The teacher discussed with the class how we need to think more and work harder to support each other when there are changes. The children then filled in a worksheet called the toolbox. The toolbox enabled the children to think about: Something I have learnt about myself, something I have learnt about friendship, something I have learnt about big feelings.

This week also we have been taking part in the exciting Talent Show. Having a winner amongst children in Year 3, made the whole Year 3 Team extremely proud. Congratulations to all participants for delivering high quality acts. Well done for your creativity and stamina performing live in front of the whole school!

Maths

In Maths, the children practised telling the time in both analogue and digital. We played Time Domino, Time Snakes and Ladders and Matching games to practice these skills. We used clocks to help us to work out the time intervals. We used 'Frog Jumps' on the number line to count on:

English
