<u>Maths</u>

Following our chocolate theme, for World Chocolate week we weighed different chocolates. We have started to explore mass, looking at units of measurement, making predictions and using a range of scales. The children have explored weight through lots of practical activities.

<u>English</u>

In English the children have continued to explore the characters and plot of Charlie and The Chocolate Factory. We have also explored how to write a diary entry and the children have considered Charlie's thoughts and feelings when he received the golden ticket. The children then begun to write their own diary entry, first person, pretending to be Charlie.

Topic: History/ PE

In History the children were introduced to Jessica Ennis. We explored facts about her and how she links to Black History Month. The children then worked in groups to research about her and chose how they wanted to present their work.

In PE, the children practiced putting their gymnastic routines to music. We explored how to turn individual movements into group movements and how different shapes and heights can be incorporated into a sequence.

Jewish Studies

The children have had an exciting week learning the songs and practising their lines for their Chaggigat HaChumash. They have been learning the songs in Hebrew and English.

<u>lvrit</u>

In Maths, the class will be continuing to build upon their knowledge and understanding of weight, prediction skills and how to read scales.

In PE, we will be continuing to deepen our knowledge and skills within gymnastics.

In Music, we will continue to look at our Chagigah HaChumash songs.
