Dear Parents,

It has been great week in Year 5. We would like to welcome Miss Stoakley, our Teaching Assistant, who joined the Year 5 Team this week. I am pleased that the children really enjoyed the Bike Ability Cycle Training.

English –The children discussed the challenges of emerging into a new culture. They enjoyed comparing the life on the island and life in London based on our class story "Jemmy Button". Also, we have continued to work on relative clauses and looking at subordinate clauses. The children were giving their opinion using Point-Evidence-Explanation strategy.

Maths- The focus this week was on consolidating the skills they gained so far. The children consolidated knowledge enabling them to read and write dates using Roman numerals, revised rounding and were finding the difference between the positive and negative numbers. They challenged themselves with word problems using all these concepts. Also, the children enjoyed the Maths Chocolate week activities.

Topic- In Art children enjoyed consolidating their sketching skills to create a portrait of Joseph Cough- the first black bus driver. In History the children were researching about the migration of people in pre-historic times looking at Jewish examples. Also, the children researched the history of chocolate, creating a timeline of the main events.

Jewish Studies- This week in Jewish Studies we began learning for our ETGAR competition by focussing on Jewish history. In Chumash we came to understand how Hashem answered Eliezer's tefillot on behalf of Avraham. We have also been reading with a focus on reading for meaning and have started to learn he tefillah we say for the State of Israel, which we hope to incorporate into our weekly Youth Service

lvrit-This week we continued to establish class rules and repeated classroom language in lvrit: שָׁלוֹם, הָיָפָא, לְמַשְׁה, לְמַצְבָּיעַ, לְהַקְשִׁיב, לְכַבֵּד, לְשֶׁבֶת, כִּיּפֵא, שׁוֹלְחָן, עִיפָּרוֹן, מַיִם, לְפְתוֹח, לְסְגוֹר, לְמַעְלָה, לְמַשָּׁה, through different activities.

Next week we will learn about the history of the Hebrew language and discuss - why are we learning lvrit?
