## Dear Parents,

This week, we celebrated Lag Ba'Omer where we had a picnic outside under canopies which were the caves that Rabbi Akiva was studying in.

English - In English this week, we imagined we lived in a community during WW2 and discussed the question: should the children in the community be evacuated? We had a debate to discuss the positives and negatives of evacuation. The following day, we became evacuees, writing our own ID cards and being picked from a line up at the 'train station', before writing a letter home to our Mums to explain about our experience. We read the first two chapters of the book, learning about the main characters Willie Beech and Tom Oakley.

Maths - In maths we have been learning how to calculate the area of compound shapes. This is a multistep problem as we not only need to multiply the sides to work out the area but we also have to add the areas together to work out the totals for the compound shape.

Topic - This week we have been learning about plants and their reproductive cycle. We learnt that the pollen is transferred from plant to plant be either animals such as Bees or by the wind. We have also been programming Pro bots to go through the trenches of WWII.

Jewish Studies - In Jewish Studies we have been revising over our ETGAR topics. We have been hot seating to test our knowledge. We also learnt about the reasons behind celebrating Lag Ba'omer. We have been reading with meaning for Hebrew reading.

The children should also be reading their 'home' books. Reading book changes take place on Monday and Friday.

The school library books can be changed or renewed on Tuesdays.
