<u>English</u>

The children learned how to plan a story and reorder the story pictures in groups. All children had a go at writing the original story of Jack and the Beanstalk.

<u>Maths</u>

The class learned how to find a half of an amount using different objects and using shapes, creating their own and completing stem sentences.

<u>Topic</u>

The children learned how animals change as they grow into adults, and which animal group humans belong to.

Jewish Studies

Another wonderful week we have had, learning all fun and exciting things! We learnt how the menorah was lit every day in the Bet Hamikdash and how we have the mitzvah of challah.

<u>lvrit</u>
